Prior's Field School was founded in 1902 by Julia Huxley, and has a fascinating history, with links to famous authors, scientists, and actresses! The school building was designed by the highly regarded architect C. F. A. Voysey, and many original features of his unique design can still be seen around the school.

Location

Set in twenty three acres of parkland just outside Godalming in Surrey, the school is just 45 minutes away from London. The South Coast, with its beautiful seaside towns and beaches, is also within easy reach, and both Gatwick and Heathrow airport are less than one hour away.

Accommodation

The bedrooms at Prior's Field School are comfortable and clean. Most of the rooms are single and have a washbasin, and there are also some small dormitories available. Showers and bathrooms are on every floor, and a weekly laundry service is offered.

Meals

Students enjoy freshly prepared food three times a day. The menu changes each week, with plenty of variety to keep students happy and healthy. Special diets can be catered for with prior notice, such as celiac, etc.

Facilities

With a sports hall, heated outdoor pool, seven tennis courts, netball courts, hockey, football, and rounders pitches, and an athletics track, the facilities offered at Prior's Field School are second to none. In addition, the large assembly hall can be used as a cinema for film nights, as well as a venue for school discos. All classrooms are bright, with modern furniture and WiFi internet access throughout the school.

Activities and Excursions

A full daily activity programme keeps our students entertained, with both afternoon and evening activities taking place every day of the week. In addition, students have one half-day and one full-day excursion every week, giving them the chance to visit London, Oxford, Brighton, Portsmouth, Winchester and more, all while under the supervision of our activity staff.

Programme includes:

- 15 hours morning tuition per week, including textbooks
- Certificate with level assessed according to CEF (Common European Framework)
- Full daily activity programme
- 1 full-day excursion each week
- 1 half-day excursion each week
- Accommodation
- Freshly prepared breakfast, lunch, dinner
